

PS - I believe this warning to be legit. If you find otherwise be sure to post your findings and I'll stand corrected.

AAA Warning-WATCH THIS!

The EPA has changed the rules on corn used to make gasoline. E-15 Gasoline will likely come to local stations sooner or later.

You need to watch this and heed the AAA warning, and see what many vehicle manufacturers are saying about use of E-15.

This also pertains to Motorcycles, mowers, chain saws and all small engines.

It looks like they are starting to promote this stuff so **be careful** what you pump into your car or light truck. <u>Pumps have to be clearly marked as offering E-15!</u> **Don't use it if you're not absolutely sure that your vehicle is designed to use it.** Most are NOT.

The cost may be slightly cheaper than the other options so it might look tempting. Most stations don't have it yet **but be aware** just in case.
