## Dave's Jordan project part II

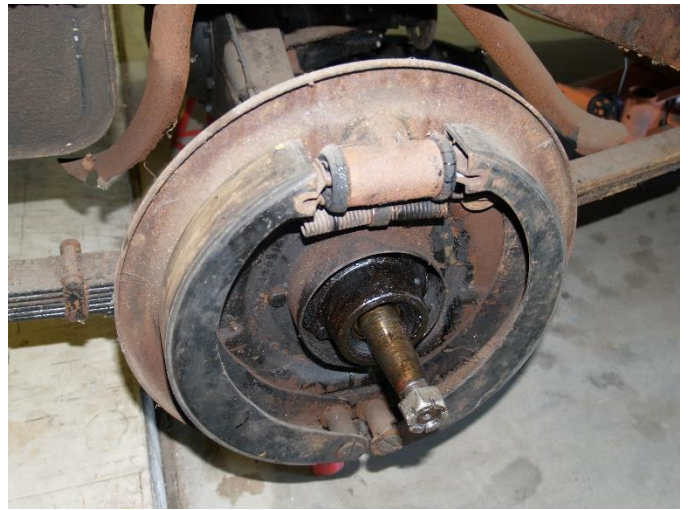


I had been hearing some good things about Dave's Jordan project and the progress made since the last time it was covered here. I spent some time directing cars at the El Mirage show last weekend with Dave Bryant and he invited me afterwards to check it out. He explained how one of our club members, Rich Mock, (you may know him as the owner of his fascinating licensed manure hauling model T pickup) had been quite helpful joining in on the project.



Notice the engine is out and in a shop waiting for some TLC. Now I don't remember all the details but Dave will be glad to bring you up to speed. Another area of progress is the brakes. This is a hydraulic system and the wheel cylinder rubber and bores are "hosed" but the

drums and shoes look good.

A picture does not do justice to the massive size and length of the oil pan. One must see it in person for themselves to appreciate.

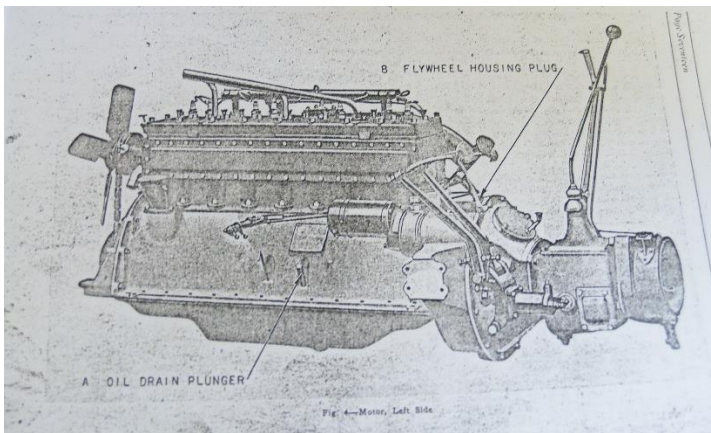


Somewhere under here lurks the gas tank. Work is also underway to free and boil it or whatever it needs to clean up and present or not present any rust holes.

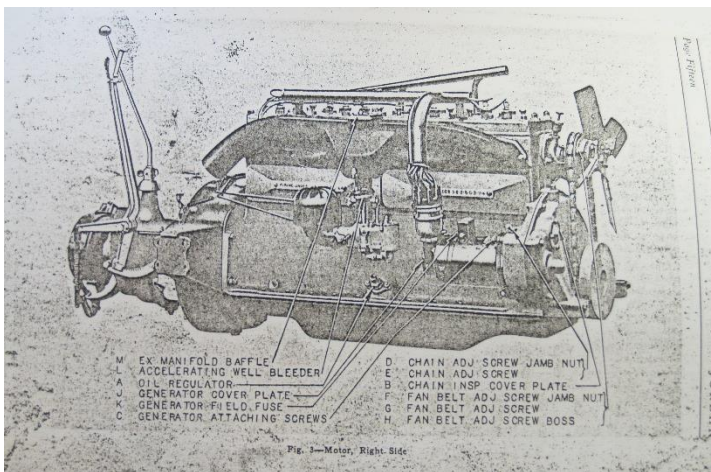

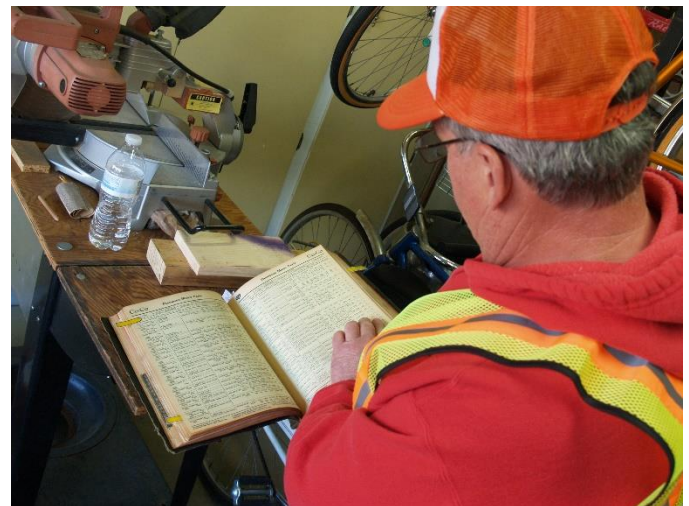
This view of the anvil like Continental engine gives a better idea of the impressive oil pan.



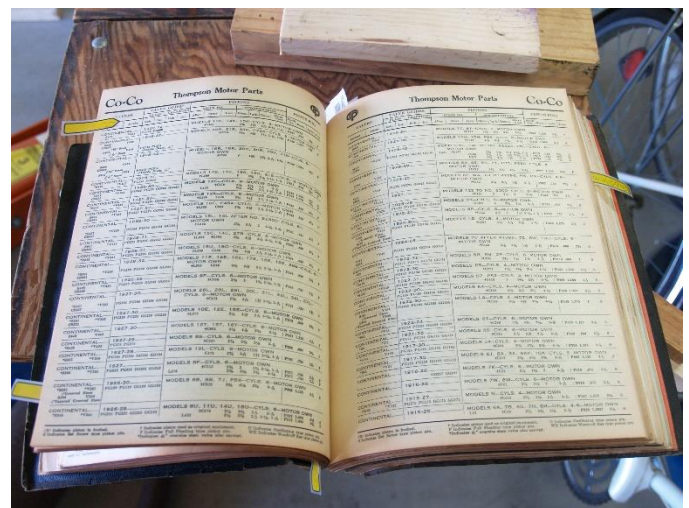
The flip side
