Changes to upcoming Events and Happenings

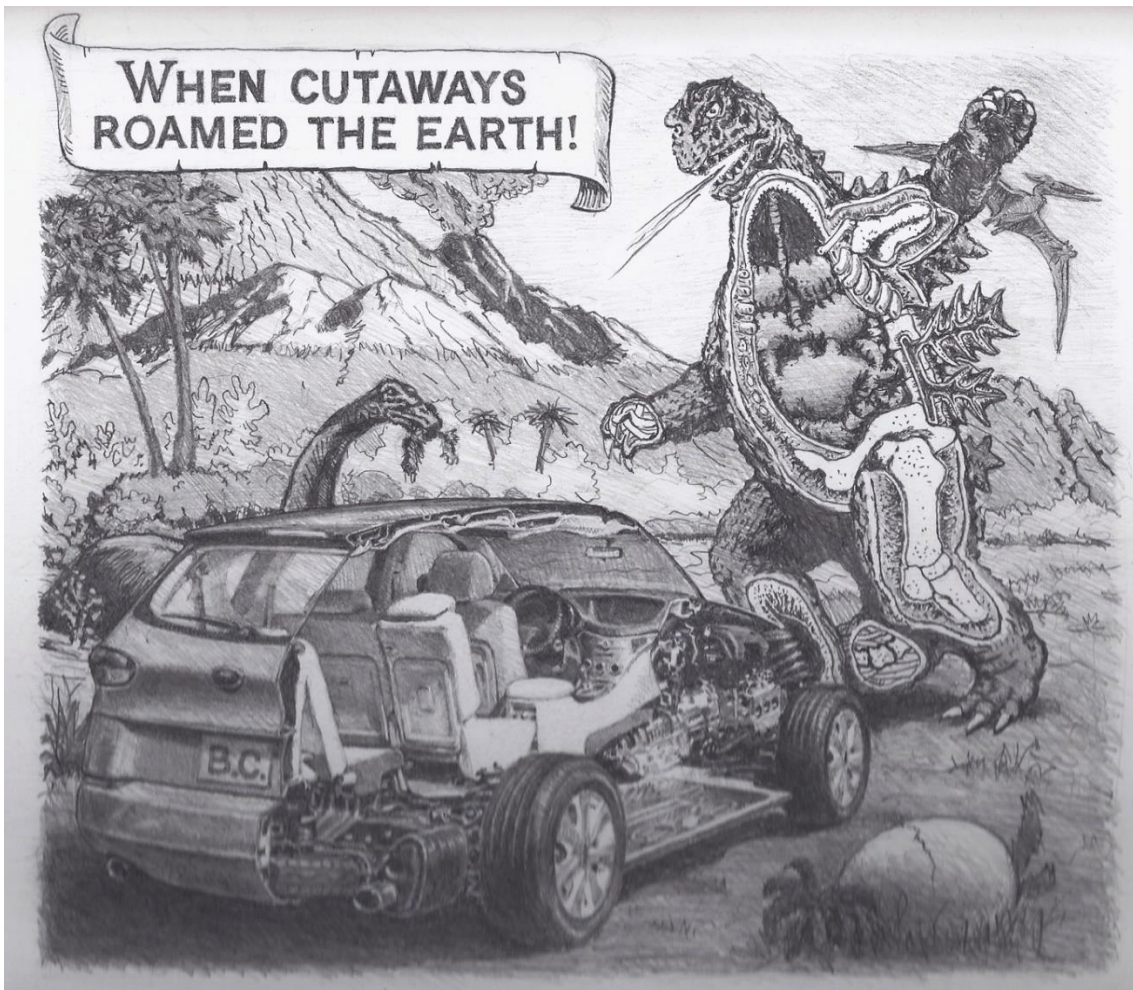

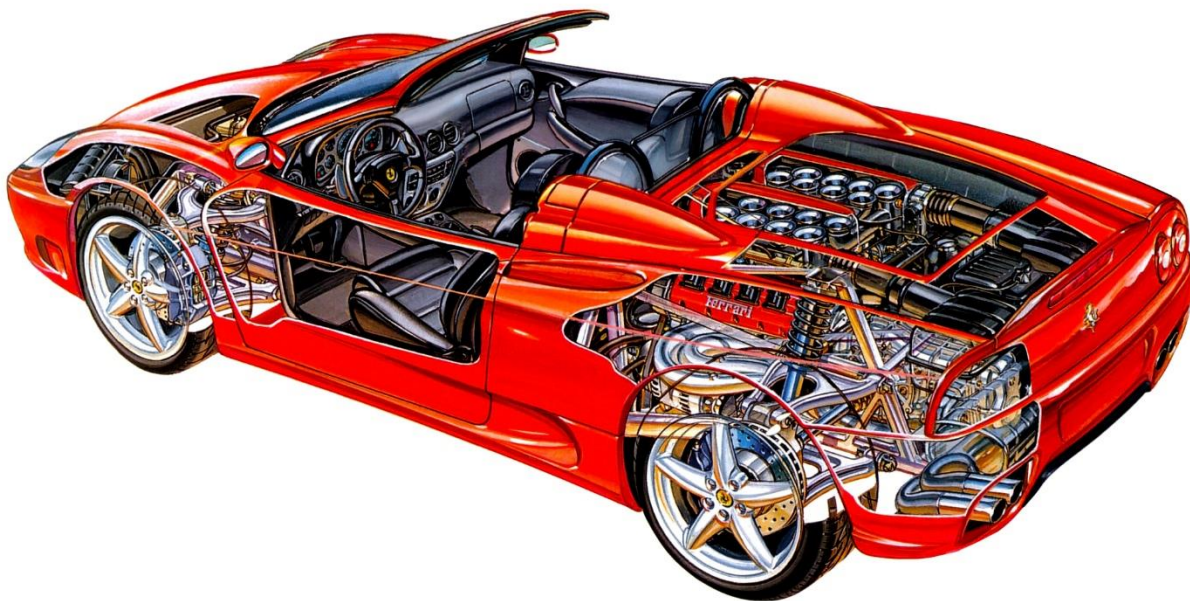

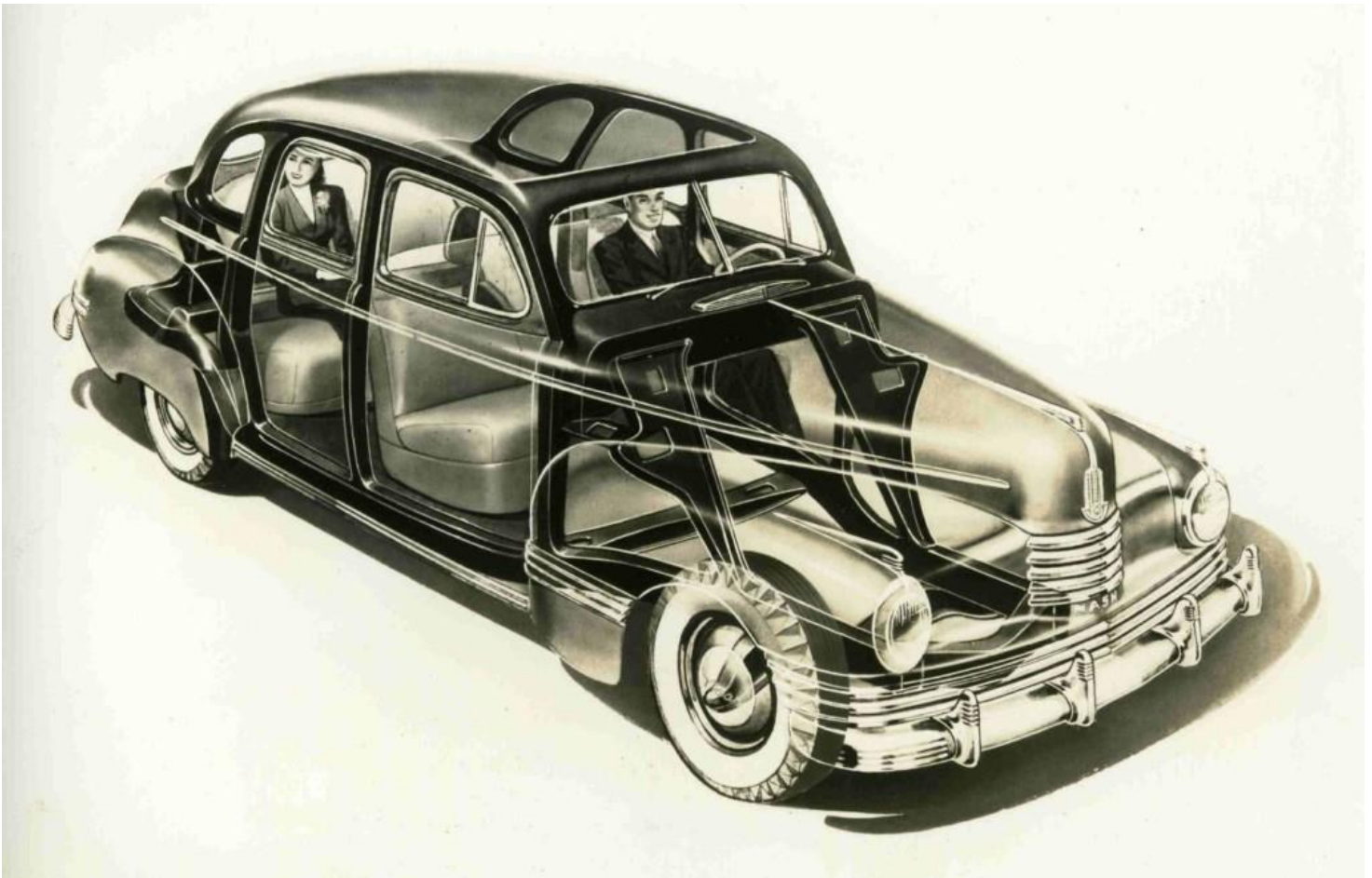

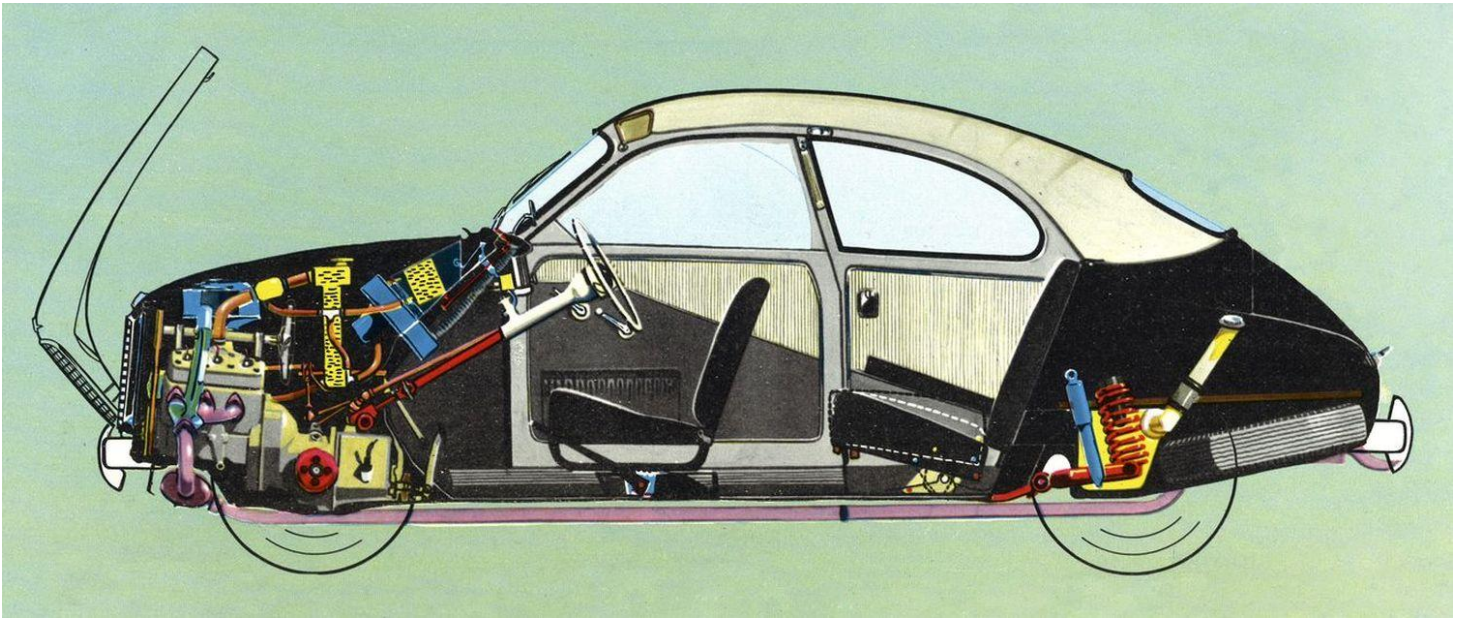

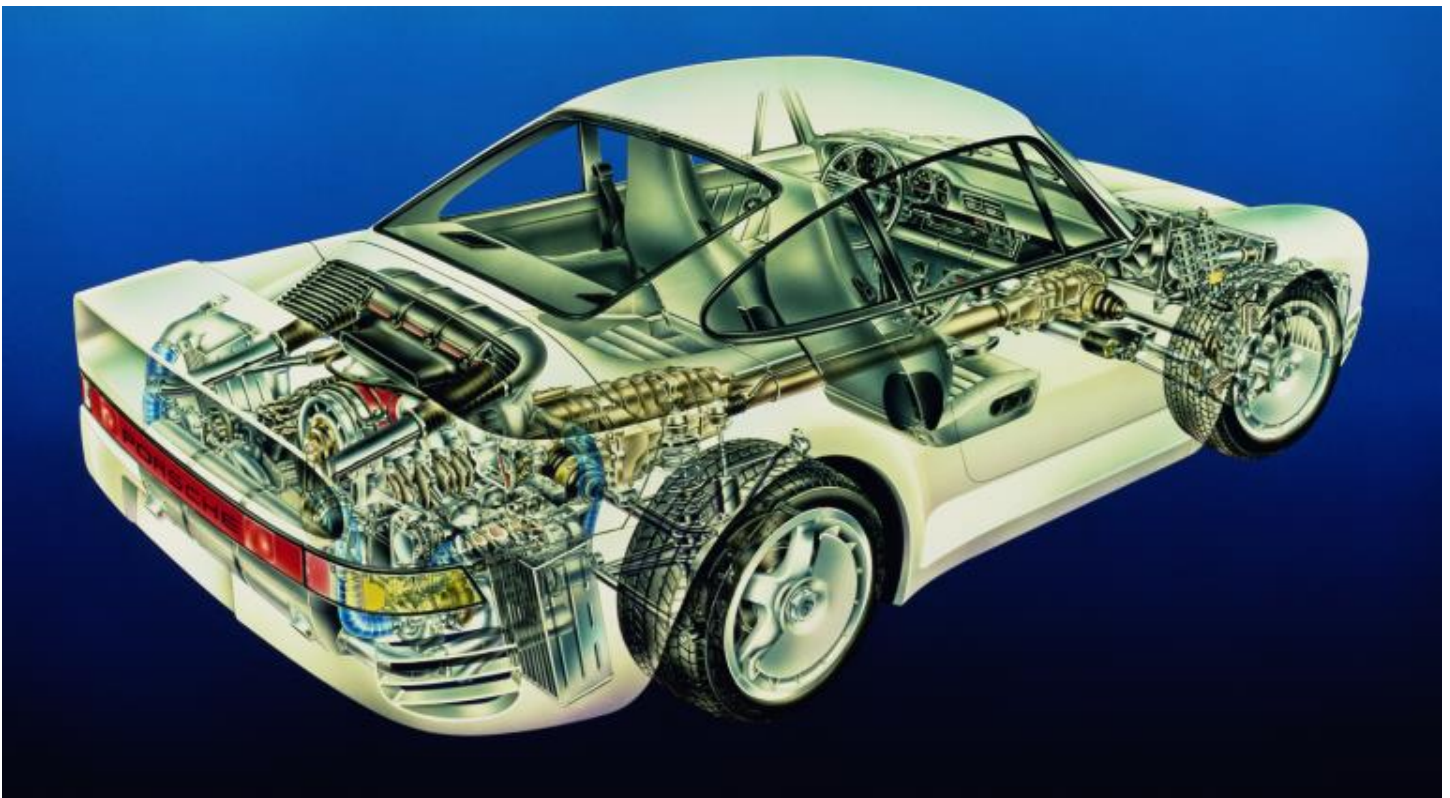

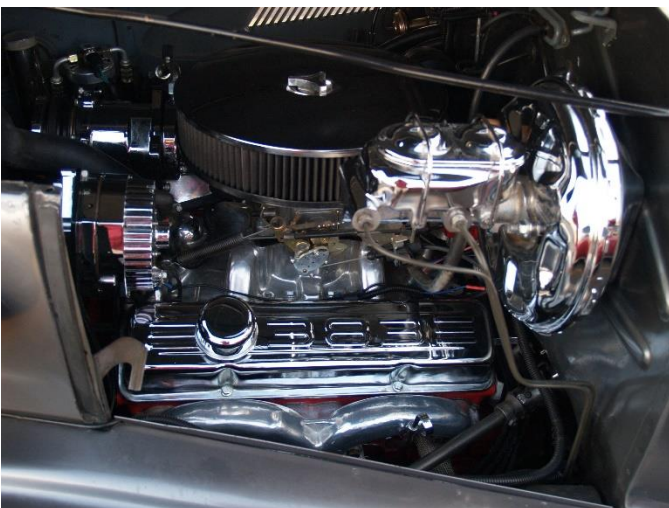
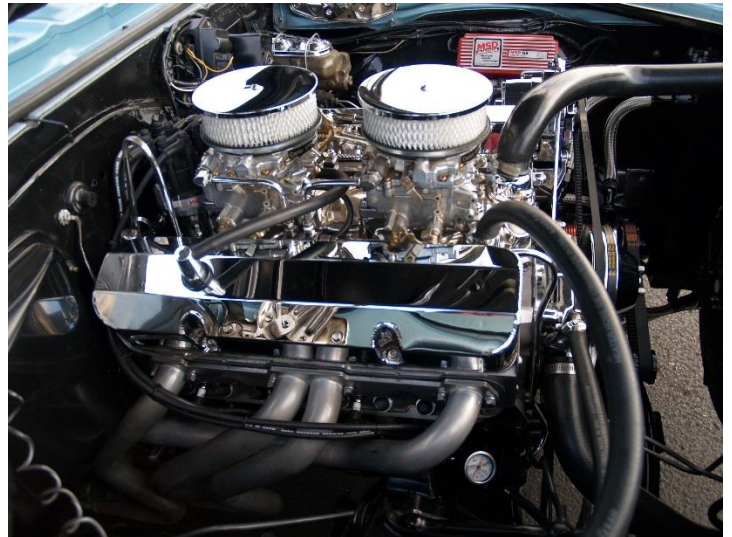
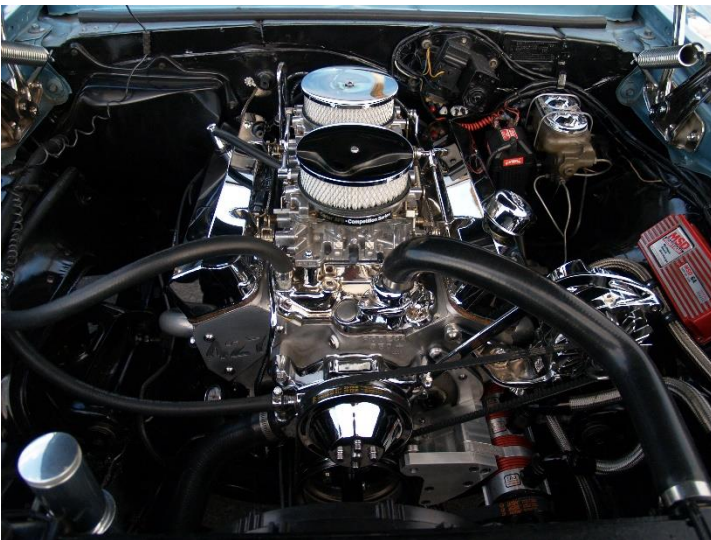
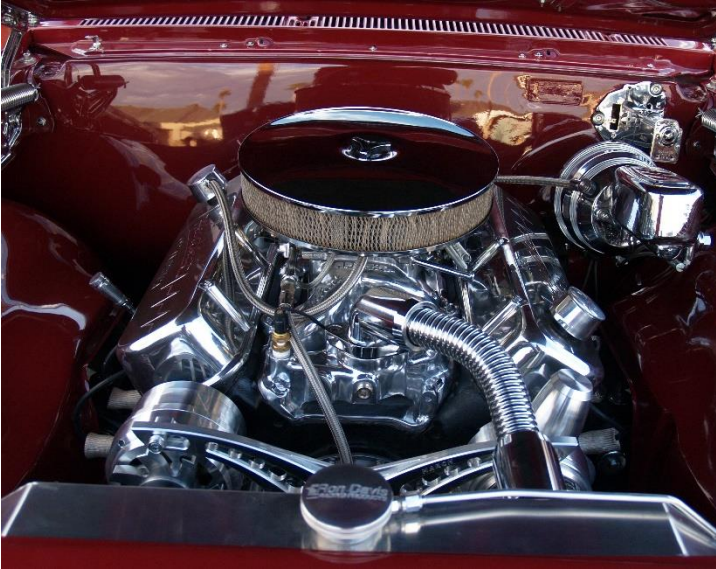
2004 Porsche Boxster S
