Favorite Recipes

Thanks, Yvonne Ahrens, for submitting her recipe for Fruit Pizza.

Crust – Mix $\frac{3}{4}$ cup soft oleo, $\frac{1}{3}$ cup powdered sugar. Add $\frac{1}{2}$ cup flour. (I use my hands). Put into 9 x 13 glass pan or large pizza pan. Bake 300 degrees until edges brown. Approx. 20 minutes. Cool.

Mix together 8 oz soft cream cheese, ½ cup sugar and 1 tsp vanilla and top cool crust. Add fruit.

Glaze -2 T cornstarch, 1 c pineapple juice, $\frac{1}{2}$ c sugar. Heat to boiling and starts to thicken. Cool.
