Lee and Toni own a beautiful 1940 Ford 2-door Sedan Standard, with a Ford 302, 300 HP engine, AT, AC, and Disc Brakes.

Lee and Toni grew up in Burbank, CA. Lee had many experiences growing up. While working for Coca-Cola Bottling Company, Lee delivered complimentary cases of Coca-Cola to the homes of movie stars, such as John Wayne, Lucille Ball, and to the pool parties at Johnny Weissmuller's home.


After living in Washington state where Lee owned a trucking company and Toni was a hairdresser, they built a home on 20 acres in Chiloquin, OR.

Chiloquin, OR is home to "Train Mountain Railroad" – TMR (www.trainmountain.org) the world's largest miniature railroad (Guinness Book of World Records). TMR is situated on 2600 acres with 36 miles of 7.5" Gauge Track. The trains are large enough to ride on throughout the miles of track. In addition to the miniature railroad, there is a museum with railroad history and 60 full-size rolling stock cars, in the collection, on display.

Lee and Toni's home and property were fortunate to be one of a special few that were on the grounds of the railroad. They had 2000 feet of their own track, and could access the club tracks from their siding. Lee and Toni owned many engines and cars that Lee had hand built from scratch to operate on the railroad. They were members of the club which numbered 400-500. Members from around the world would bring their cars and engines to operate on the club's tracks. Lee and Toni sold their Oregon home a few years ago, but they retain some of their train cars.
