Alan and Ann have had a home in Sun City since 2016 and have been members of the VVSC Car Club since 2016. Alan has served on the VVSC Board of Directors since 2019, as the Membership Director through 2022, and now as First Vice President. Thank you, Alan, for your service and volunteerism.

Alan and Ann both grew up in the farming community of Osage, Iowa. Alan received a Mechanical Engineering Degree at Iowa State. They currently have a home in Michigan.

Alan was the drummer in a band, in High School called "The Lil Varmints", and later joined two others in what became an upper Midwest favorite called "Hot Jam". During the 1970's "Hot Jam" toured with the likes of bands...Chicago, Bachman Turner Overdrive, Heart, and many others. "Hot Jam" wrote and performed their own songs, releasing multiple singles, and selling out venues across the upper Midwest.

They were in the process of releasing their first album in 1979 when their manager disappeared with all of their savings. Unfortunately, they were forced to pause production and eventually decided to call it quits.

On September 5, 2021, "Hot Jam" was inducted into the Iowa Rock & Roll Hall of Fame Class of 2021.

"In 2011, I took delivery of a 2012 Boss 302, which was race red and white stripes, and ordered for me from a dealer in Prescott, as I could find no Phoenix dealers that would sell me one at MSRP. Seems they were all going over MSRP. Sadly, life caused me to sell it. I always regretted that, and could not forget the 2012 Boss 302's.

A few years back I found a mint one for sale that you see below which is pictured in my backyard climate-controlled garage in Sun City. It is number 1938 of the total production run of 2012 Boss 302's, of only 3290. Always a desert car it was sold new at Future Ford of Clovis, CA. and had been in storage for a long time when I got it. It's stock and has won many car shows, including 2019 10th Annual All American Car Show sponsored by Desert Sands Corvette, winning first place Mustang 2000 and newer class. It also won first place at 2-10-18 ARC Car show in best 2000 and newer stock class. It's low mileage, and I think handles better than a recent model Corvette that I once had. Back in 1970 I drove a used 1970 Boss 302 and my 2012 Boss 302 would run circles around the 1970 one.

Just think - only 3290, 2012 Boss 302's, were built compared to 3300 of the one year run of Dodge Demons. These numbers are from Ford and Dodge. Boss 302's were only made in 2012 and 2013, then never again. The first year of 2012 I like better due to its styling which differs from the 2013."
