

## Featured Member Spotlight! – Herb Carson



Herb was born in Colton, CA, graduating from high school in Barstow, CA. Growing up he learned patience riding the school bus over 100 miles roundtrip, daily, along famous Route 66. Following high school, Herb advanced his education, graduating from the "Hollywood Electronic Academy." After a visit to Iowa, Herb met his future wife and settled in the Cedar Rapids area of the Hawkeye State, raising two children, eventually living just outside Anamosa, IA.

Following his electronic education, Herb worked for Iowa Electric Light & Power calibrating watt hour meters, before signing on at Collins Radio where he oversaw several areas over the years, from Quality Control Supervisor, Environmental Testing, Avionics, Communications, even being involved in providing equipment and support for the Apollo and other missions into Space.

After retiring in 1986, for the next ten years, Herb and his wife did a lot of traveling in the US and around the world. They roamed the US in a variety of RV's – campers, fifth wheels, and motorhomes. Some of that time included bringing along his Goldwing motorcycle for exploring, as well.

Herb moved to AZ in 1998, first settling in the East Valley. Searching for a community that would welcome a large antenna that he needed for his amateur radio hobby; they found there were a lot of radio guys in Sun City and chose this for their home.

Herb has always had an interest in cars. In the Cedar Rapids area, he belonged to the Antique Automobile Club of America, traveling to and participating in events around the country.

Herb's first love was a 1940 Desoto Convertible which he owned for several years in the late 40's. Herb saved up for a longtime to collect the \$465 needed to buy the car.

Herb joined the Vintage Vehicles of Sun City in about 2017. In addition to his membership in the Vintage Vehicles of Sun City, Herb is, and has been a member for many years, of the C.A.R.S. Club of Sun City.




