Treasurer Report: Connie Sherman- On February 1, 2026 the checking balance was \$26,213.74, with an income of \$10,457.29. Expenses were \$9487.39. Checking balance as of 2/28/25 was \$26,870.72. Money Market as of 2/28/25 was \$11,316.17. Petty cash \$250. Two CD's \$19,598.74. The total is \$58,035.63. Connie said there was \$8,643. profit in one day, for the Spring Fling. The adjusted total of profit from the Fling after expenses, is a whopping \$30,430.00!!! Great show! And thanks to everyone who stepped up to help.
